# July Evergreen Camera Club Program presented by ECC Members

Evergreen Camera Club featured the annual "Member Show and Tell." We had six members, presenting for 10 minutes each. Donna Dannen shared her love of dog pho-

tography out-of-doors, with an emphasis on using dog "models" to enhance pictures taken along the Colorado hiking trails.

Owen Newnan pre-

sented what he had learned comparing lenses using the DxO Mark website, a free data base. He compared lenses with different cameras to help him decide what equipment to purchase. DxO compares sharpness, dis-

tortion, vignetting, transmission and lens chromatic aberration paired with different cameras. It turns out camera choice does make a difference!

Dave Nelson shared videos and stills he had taken with a GoPro camera mounted on his bicycle. He also presented an interesting time lapse of a flower blooming using the GoPro, as well as 2 mm wide

angle shots.

Jennifer Swanagon discussed her coffee-table book, "Gratitude," incorporating images and words to illustrate a compilation of a an impressive impact on her website, with over 600,000 hits mid-year after publishing!

Tom Goldberg shared knowledge he has learned on native plant walks in the Open Space Parks, led by a Native Plant Master. He used a super zoom for his photos and created a nice compilation of the flowers he has learned.

Ellen Nelson showed techniques to photograph water. She explained the technicalities of how the camera can create different "looks" for waterfalls or creeks. She also explained the beauty of the symmetry of reflections, and how to best capture water using filters to create the most successful effects.
