As photographers, we are continually striving to keep our images fresh and interesting. Joseph Roybal, a landscape and travel photographer based out of Denver, presented some insightful recommendations in his presentation titled, "Off the Beaten Path."

Capturing the iconic shot is great, but he encouraged us to look deeper for creative inspiration. Less common locations are beautiful, unique and inspiring, but it may take



a bit of planning and research, especially when visiting remote locations. Joseph utilized several apps to search for potential venues.

One of his favorite apps is Google Earth, and he demonstrated some helpful tips to optimize a search.

He also stressed the importance of photographers keeping locations as pristine as

possible. Social Media is a great place to share our work but be mindful of the impact it can have on the locations we have visited. He suggested no hashtags and turning the GPS off in your camera.

Joseph provided an abundance of useful information and ended his presentation stressing the importance to "find your own voice" and be genuine to who you are as a photographer.
