



Cary Wolfson's presentation on iPhone photography illustrated to us that there is



"Go for more than technical perfection,"

fore" and "after" results using "Snapseed" ("My favorite app, and did I mention it is free?"), "Luminar," "iColorama" and others with incredible outcomes, including one that allows you to make an image of water come to life and appear to flow! He also combines apps and uses lens attachments.

Cary went on a photo workshop recently in Oaxaca, Mexico, bringing only his iPhone. He was so inspired he is returning next month.
