RAW OR JPEG?

- ▶ If you want your images ready-to-show: JPEG
- ▶ If you will be using LightRoom*: RAW
 - ▶ Only ISO, Exposure, Aperture, and Focus count
 - ▶ All camera “scene” settings are ignored
 - ▶ Generally RAW pictures will look bad until adjusted
 - ▶ Use a GOOD CALIBRATED Monitor

*any post processing

USER INTERFACE REVIEW

- ▶ Viewing Area
- ▶ File Selector
- ▶ Controls
- ▶ Film Strip
- ▶ Border Extras
- ▶ Keyboard Shortcuts

LIBRARY

- ▶ Where:
 your Pictures Folder
- ▶ Multiple Libraries:
 just say no
- ▶ Organize:
 by date or major groups by date
- ▶ Importing, Picking and Rating
- ▶ Collections
 - ▶ Quick Collection
- ▶ Keywords

DEVELOP

- ▶ Crop
- ▶ Exposure — Color — White/Black Levels
- ▶ For Pop: Vibrance — Clarity — Sharpness — Dehaze
- ▶ Post-crop Vignette — Highlight Priority, ~11
- ▶ Fixes: Spot Removal — Radial Filter — Graduated Filter

- ▶ Lightroom Edits are all “procedural”
 - ▶ Stored as instructions, not pixels
